Police are appealing for any witnesses to the theft of a generator from Pillaton, Saltash, between 20 and 23 October 2017. The thieves cut through armoured cable to remove the generator from the field where it was stored.

The generator is described as a Perkins 35K VA diesel generator. It is painted blue over white so that both colours show.

If you are offered equipment rental (also known as plant hire) or tools at low prices from the back of a van, please take the registration number of the vehicle and as much detail as you can about the items and seller. Contact 101 to advise Police. This is the main way that officers are able to reunite goods with their owners. Please also keep a record of serial numbers for tools and plant and/or [property mark](#) them. Thank you.
