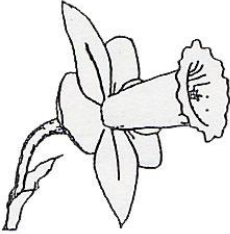

## DAFFODIL CLASSIFICATION



### DIVISION 1: TRUMPET DAFFODILS

One flower to a stem; corona ('trumpet') at least as long as, or longer than, the perianth segments ('petals').



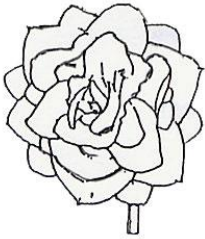
### DIVISION 2: LARGE-CUPPED DAFFODILS

One flower to a stem; corona ('cup') more than one third, but less than equal to the length of the perianth segments ('petals').



### DIVISION 3: SMALL-CUPPED DAFFODILS

One flower to a stem; corona ('cup') not more than one third of the length of the perianth segments ('petals').



### DIVISION 4: DOUBLE DAFFODILS

One or more flowers to a stem; with doubling of the perianth segments or the corona or both.

## *Section 1*

### **Bulbs and Corms**

Daffodils - please state the name of each variety or specify name unknown. Narcissi are classed as daffodils for show purposes.

**Trumpet daffodils - trumpet to be at least as long as the petals.**

1. Trumpet daffodil - 1 single bloom
2. Trumpet daffodil - 3 stems of any one variety

**Large cupped daffodil - cup to be more than one third the length of the petal but less than the full length of the petal.**

3. Large cupped daffodil - 1 single bloom
4. Large cupped daffodil - 3 stems of any one variety

**Small cupped daffodil - cup to be not more than one third of the length of the petals.**

5. Small cupped daffodil - 1 single bloom
6. Small cupped daffodil - 3 stems of any one variety

**Double daffodil - one or more flowers to a stem with doubling of the petals or the cup or both.**

7. Double daffodil - 1 single bloom
8. Double daffodil - 3 stems of any one variety

**Split corona - corona (cup) split for at least one third of its length.**

**Corona may be split evenly into either 3 or 6 sections.**

9. Split corona daffodil - 1 single bloom
10. Split corona daffodil - 3 stems of any one variety

**Cyclamineus - perianth segments (petals) folded back towards the stem.**

11. Cyclamineus daffodil - 1 single bloom
12. Cyclamineus daffodil - 3 stems of any one variety

**Any other division - can include multi-headed or any other variety not included in the above categories.**

13. Miniature daffodil - 1 single stem
14. Miniature daffodil - 3 stems of any one variety
15. Any other division - 1 single bloom
16. Any other division - 3 stems of any one variety
- 16a. 7 stems of mixed daffodils

## **Tulips**

- 17. 1 single tulip bloom
- 18. 3 stems of tulips of any variety

## ***Section 2***

### **Spring Flowers - Senior Classes**

#### **Primroses**

- 19. 1 bunch of 10 yellow garden primroses with leaves
- 20. 1 bunch of 10 coloured primroses with leaves

#### ***Primula/Polyanthus***

- 21. 1 bunch of 5 stems of mixed colours with foliage

#### **Violets**

- 22. 1 bunch with foliage

#### **Any other spring flower**

- 23. 1 single stem of any spring flower other than above
- 24. 1 bunch of any spring flower other than above - single variety
- 25. 1 bunch of any spring flower other than above -mixed varieties

## ***Section 3***

### **Spring Flowers - Junior Classes**

- 26. Best bunch of garden primroses - no limit to size. To be judged on neatness, quality and freshness of flowers. Primrose foliage may be used, but no other.
- 27. 1 bunch of any varieties of mixed Spring flowers

## ***Section 4***

### **Shrubs**

#### ***Rhododendron***

- 28. 1 stem of *Rhododendron* flowers
- 29. 1 stem of azalea flowers

## ***Camellia***

- 30. 1 single bloom of *Camellia* - single flowered variety
- 31. 1 single bloom of *Camellia* - semi-double
- 32. 1 single bloom of *Camellia* - double
- 33. 1 single bloom of *Camellia* - peony flowered variety
- 34. 1 single bloom of *Camellia* - anemone flowered variety

## ***Magnolia***

- 35. 1 *Magnolia* – single large bloom
- 36. 1 stem of *Magnolia* – *stellata* type

## ***Forsythia***

- 37. 1 flowering stem of *Forsythia*

## ***Viburnum***

- 38. 1 flowering stem of *Viburnum*

## **Any other flowering shrub**

- 39. 1 stem of any flowering shrub other than above

## **Foliage shrubs**

- 40. 1 single stem of any variegated shrub - not in bloom
- 41. 1 single stem of any non-variegated shrub - not in bloom



SINGLE - not more than 9 petals, with central boss of stamens



SEMI-DOUBLE - 2 or more rows of petals, stamens conspicuous



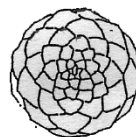
ANEMONE\_FORM - flat, with one or more rows of large outer petals and a central convex mass of twisted petaloids and stamens



PAEONY-FORM - deep and rounded, with several rows of outer petals and a central convex mass of twisted petaloids and stamens



ROSE-FORM - several rows of overlapping petals, showing stamens in a concave mass when fully open



FORMAL DOUBLE - many rows of neatly overlapping petals obscuring the central stamens

**Mixed Flowers and/or Shrubs. Maximum container size 18 in (50cm) diameter**

Classes for the **Photography** section in the Summer Schedule will be:

1. Seascape
2. Flower(s)
3. Your garden
4. British wildlife
5. Best photograph
6. Most amusing (with caption)

Junior (14 and under) entries will be judged separately.



## **RULES OF ENTRY**

1. All entries to be received by **7 pm** on **THURSDAY 16th MARCH 2023**.
2. **STRICTLY** no entries will be accepted after that date.
3. All flowers must be grown by exhibitors on their own ground, except floral art materials. Pot plants should have been in the exhibitor's care for at least 3 months.
4. When staging 3 daffodil blooms please note that 1 bloom should be on top and 2 blooms underneath. Blooms may be steadied with moss and 3 leaves used for foliage when appropriate (foliage is optional).
5. One person may enter no more than two entries of the same variety in the same class.
6. Staging to take place from 7.30 pm to 9.00 pm on Friday 17th March and 8.00 am to 9.45 am on Saturday 18th March. Hall to be cleared of exhibitors by 9.45 am.
7. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any entries that do not conform to the rules.
8. All exhibits to be left in place until 3.45 pm.
9. The judge's decision is final.
10. Judging will take place at 10 am.
11. Exhibitors must not steward any section they have entered.
12. Points will be awarded towards trophies as follows:  
1st 4 points, 2nd 3 points, 3rd 2 points, Highly Commended 1 point.
13. All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits, but the Committee cannot be held responsible for any damage by accident or otherwise.
14. Entrants to Junior Classes must be under 15 on the day of the Show.
15. Children may enter Adult Classes but will be judged as an adult.
